



In the fourth and final generation, a single post emerges from the center of the sole plate. These are steam irons; the tanks hanging off the backs are water reservoirs. Proctor also made a dry version (less tank). For reasons unknown, the red ones are labeled "Windsor." There are also versions with a translucent green or an opaque blue tank (both not pictured).
